ADMISSION TO M.A.(ENGLISH) and M.Sc.(CHEMISTRY)

M.A. (English):

1. Total Seats Available: Sixty (60)

2. Eligibility for Admission:

Only those candidates who have passed their Bachelor degree not before 2021 and have obtained 45% marks in Graduation and should have English in B.A. -III or B.A. with 55% for those who have not studied English at Graduation Level are eligible for admission.

3. Fees:

M.Sc. (Chemistry):

Total Seats Available: Forty (40)

2. Eligibility for Admission:

Only those candidates who have passed B.Sc., (not before 2021), with Chemistry as one of the subjects in third year and have obtained at least 45% marks.

3. Fees:

M.Sc. (Chemistry) Sem I & II Rs. 34,075.00*
M.Sc. (Chemistry) Sem III & IV Rs. 34,075.00*

The College reserves the right to change the fees.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

University of Lucknow guidelines regarding eligibility for seeking admission to MA (English) and M.Sc. (Chemistry) classes

According to the rules prescribed by the University of Lucknow.

- In case the candidate seeks admission in the subject (English) which he/she has studied in all three years of graduation, the eligibility will be minimum 45% of marks overall in graduation for General and OBC category and 40% for SC/ST category.
- In case the candidate seeks admission in English, which he/she has studied in the first two years of graduation but not in the final year, the eligibility will be minimum 55% marks overall.
- In case the candidate seeks admission in English which he/she has not studied in any year of graduation, eligibility will be minimum 60% marks overall.
- Science/ Commerce graduates applying for admission to M.A. are required to have a minimum of 60% marks in graduation. Students who don't have the subject English in B A III year should have a minimum of 55% in graduation.

For M. Sc. Chemistry, students with graduation from any recognized University with Chemistry as one of the subjects in B. Sc. III with minimum marks 45% for Gen/OBC candidates and 40% for SC/ST candidates.

The College has a total of 60 self-finance seats for M.A.(English) and 40 seats for M.Sc.(Chemistry). Interested students may apply through online and offline mode as suggested in the prospectus. Students should make sure that they meet the eligibility criteria of the University of Lucknow. Once purchased the form and prospectus charges shall not be refunded.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission for the I semester of academic session 2025-26 is open for both boys and girls for M.A.(English) & M.Sc. (Chemistry).

Application for admission to the first semester of M.A. (English) and M.Sc. (Chemistry) for Academic Session 2025-26 can be submitted **online as well as offline**.

Offline Submission:

For offline submission the admission forms will be available on a payment of Rs. 850/- (Eight Hundred and Fifty only) on all working days from 10:00am to 02:00pm from the College Office. The completed application forms will be accepted between the dates mentioned below:

M.A. English May 01, 2025 onwards
M.Sc. Chemistry May 01, 2025 - June 20, 2025

NOTE: The Application Form once issued will not be taken back and no refund of fees paid will be made in any circumstances.

- 1. Venue: College Admission Office
- Admissions to the above courses will be on the basis of merit only. There shall be no Entrance Test
- In case of M.A. English the admission will be granted strictly on the basis of merit but on first come first serve basis. An interview will be conducted every Saturday for the candidates, who will apply during that week, by the committee appointed by the Principal and the admission will be granted immediately to successful candidates till all seats are full. As soon as the seats are full the application process will be stopped.
- In case of M.Sc. Chemistry merit list will be displayed on 23 June, 2025 on the college website and the college notice boards. The Counselling date for admission will be notified thereafter.

Note: Any change in the dates and time mentioned above will be communicated through the college notice board and college website.

- 3.a. Selected candidates shall have to produce:
- Original marksheets of High School, Intermediate or equivalent examination and Bachelor's Degree.
- ii. Original Migration Certificate (not for graduates of Lucknow University)
- iii. Two attested copies of marksheets of Bachelor's Degree and Migration certificate, each.
- iv. Original Character Certificate from the institution last attended.
- One recent Passport size photograph (facing the Camera).
- vi. Original Privilege Certificate

All the attested photocopies of the documents have to be signed by the candidate before the admission committee.

- b. Selected candidates will be issued a fee-receipt, his/her Identity Card and College Roll No. by the admission committee. Non-payment of fee within time, shall result in the cancellation of admission.
- All information related to admissions will be displayed on the College Notice Board and the College web-site. The college will not be responsible for notifying any candidate individually.

4. PAYMENT OF FEES FOR THE SESSION 2025-26:

Selected candidates will be required to pay the fee (which is non-refundable) within the specified time duration, only in the form of a crossed Bank Draft/Banker's Cheque issued by any of the nationalised banks in favour of "Principal, Lucknow Christian Degree College" payable at Lucknow.
